Dinosaurs have arrived in Kindy!

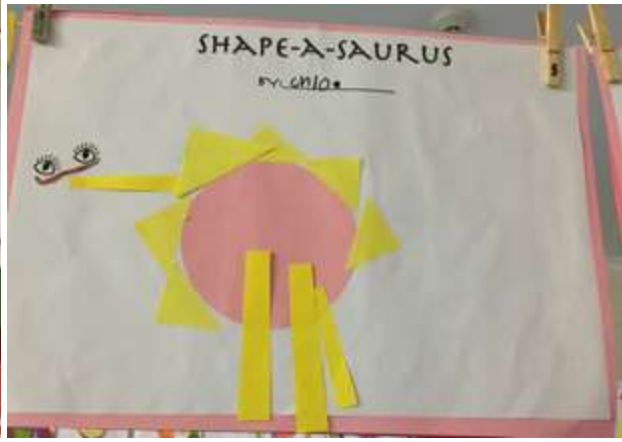


