Pre-Primary and Year 1



Pre-Primary and Year 1 have now completed their 'Look, Listen!' unit. They tried to identify an object inside a mystery box, but realised that it was too difficult to see, as no light was able to enter the box. We tried several things to make the object easier to see.



Students also made a human model of soundwaves being created and travelling to an ear.



## Year 2 and 3



As part of their 'All Mixed Up' unit, our Year 2 and 3 students have been experimenting with all kinds of different mixtures.



We have realised that mixtures are very common in every household. These are just a few examples.

### Year 4 and 5

Year 4 and 5 have begun their new unit 'Material World'. In this unit, students have been learning about the common properties and uses of everyday textiles, such as nylon, cotton, denim, leather, wool, polyester and many more.

Year 6 students have been learning all about the different kinds of tectonic plate movements that cause earthquakes, as part of their 'Earthquake Explorers' unit. They used plasticine to make models of the different types of plate movements.
